## **RELEVANT – THE SETUP**

## **BELONG**

1. Ask about highs and lows since you last met.
2. What was your New Year's resolution last year? How did you do?
3. What are some thoughts you have from the message?

## **BELIEVE**

4. Andy said, "The Bible is reliable". What does that statement mean?  
Reliable for what?
5. How does your life match up with your thoughts on the Bible's reliability?  
Why is that?
6. As we get ready to go through the Bible in a year together, what kind of experience do you bring into this journey? Have you read the Bible straight through before? Have you tried and quit? How could your past efforts impact you this time? What will help us to succeed this year?
7. Andy said, "Everything points to Jesus". When you read the Bible is that a normal lens you read through? Does Jesus show up in the Old Testament when you read?
8. It's scary to think that we could be like the guys on the road to Emmaus and completely miss Jesus, even though we know a lot of things about him. Share a present-day example of what this looks like?

## **BECOME**

9. "The goal is to see Jesus." We can pat ourselves on the back for finishing a spiritual task or discipline, but if we miss Jesus, we miss everything. What are ways we can keep this goal in front of us?
10. What is your level of commitment during this series? What can we as a group do for you to encourage you?
